

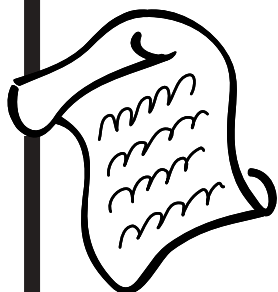

meeting and since there were no contested seats, the slate was accepted by acclamation. The 2006 Officers are none other than;

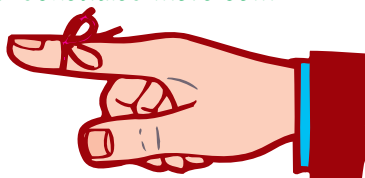
Red Proctor of Thor Motors for President
