Legislature

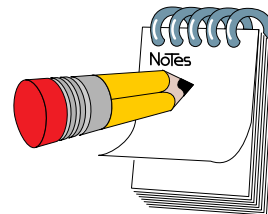
The legislative watchdog committee for this year will consist of:

Chuck Rose reports that the Department of Transportation Motorcycle Safety Task Force has finally voted to recommend that the Director approve the MSF Basic Rider Course and the Rider Coach

Trainer curriculum, as modified to comply with

the Hawaii Administrative Rules. It is

expected that the Director will accept the

task force recommendation by the time you

read this and that riders who complete the

military motorcycle safety courses will now

receive the same license skills test waiver and

insurance benefits as graduates of the State run

course taught by LCC. This will also open the door to private sector

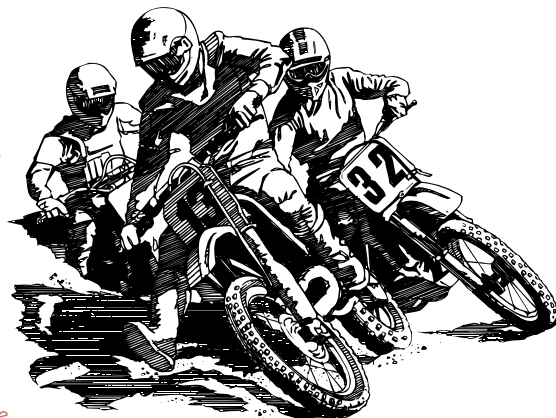
operators who wish to offer motorcycle safety training. This is especially

good news for motorcyclists and dealers on the neighbor islands.

Ross Montgomery said the HMDA needs to support racetrack efforts and the board agreed that legislative pressure would probably be the best way. 
